1. Sin is seldom unique.
 - “My people have committed two sins”
 - Two Commandments/Two Sins (Matt. 22:36-40)
 - The universality of sin (1 Corinthians 10:13)

2. Every sin is a rejection of God’s provision.
 - “They have forsaken me, the spring of living water”
 - The Primary Source (Psalm 62:1)
 - The One who satisfies (John 4:13-14)
 - Staying connected (John 15:5)

3. Every sin is a sad substitute for God’s best.
 - “and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water.”
 - Trust transformation (Jeremiah 2:5)
 - Ambushed appetites (Numbers 11:4-6)
 - Moving from broken to blessed (Joel 2:12-13)
