1. The dramatic setting: a bone-chilling vision

2. The definitive moment: a life-shaping conviction
 - Ezekiel 37:3
 - Some of God’s greatest questions (Genesis 3:9; Jeremiah 32:27; John 21:17; Job 40:8)

3. The miraculous partnership: a world-changing power
 - Ezekiel 37:4-11
 - The voice of truth (John 8:31-32)
 - The action of faith (Hebrews 11 “by faith . . .”)
 - The movement of God (Exodus 34:10; Mark 10:27)
 - The nation of Israel (Ezekiel 37:12-14; May 14, 1948)
